The signing of the Declaration of Principles marks a new era in the history of the Middle East. In firm conviction thereof, I would like to confirm the following PLO committeents:of Israel

The PLO recognizes the right of the State of Israel to exist in peace and security.

Peace Process

#### **Terrorism**

The PLO accepts United Nations Security Council Resolutions 242

#### **Anti-Semitism**

The PLO commits itself to the Middle Festimence process, and to a peaceful resolution of the conflict between the two sides and declares that all outstanding issules মধ্যা মের্লা মার্লা be resolved through negotiations<sub>Humanitarian Aid</sub>

The PLO considers that the signing of the Declaration of Principles constitutes a historic event, inaugurating one myepoch of peaceful coexistence, free from violence and all other acts which endanger peace and stability. Accordingly, Men Librarioes the use of terrorism and other acts of violence and will assume responsibility over all PLO elements and personnel in order to assure their compliance, prevent violations ar Quaisephmer Wolators.

#### **News Archive**

In view of the pormise of a new era and the signing of the Declaration of Principles and based on Palestinian acceptance of Security Council Resolutions 242 and 338, the PLO affirms that those articles of the Palestinian Covenant which deny Israel's right to exist, and the provisions of the Covenant which are inconsistent with the commitments of this letter are now inoperative and no longer valid. Consequently, the PLO undertakes to submit to the Palestinian National Council for formal approval the necessary changes in regard to the Palestinian Covenant.
